FROM THE INTERIM RECTOR...

Dear Friends,

With the approach of the summer season, the parish waits eagerly for the manifestation of the new rector. Who will it be? Will it be a he or a she? Whoever it will be represents the choice of our leaders and the spirit from amongst over seventy original candidates that have been screened by the search committee.

When the decision has been made, your parish leadership will begin to focus on assisting the new rector to move to the Swarthmore area and be introduced to the parish. The members of the search committee will at that time be invited to a ceremony at a Sunday service of thanksgiving and decommissioning from their important lay ministry.

There is always a formal service of installation for every new rector, usually with the Bishop or a Dean presiding. I am sure it will be scheduled when the parish family can conveniently join in this new beginning.

Both Joyce and I will conduct services this summer until the change in rectorship is complete. It is possible Joyce will be asked to stay on as Sunday Associate by the new rector, but that decision will be made at a later time.

Other plans are already afoot for the coming fall season to help ensure a smooth transition. The calendar meeting recently mapped out all the important fall parish events assigning them dates similar to last year's. Robin Shields and Anne Hollyer have agreed to coordinate the Church School for a second year, along with the members of the Christian Education committee. The members of the vestry have selected their officers and have assigned themselves to leadership of the 12 standing vestry committees. The stewardship committee has announced its first event for the season – a brunch following the 10 AM Service on June 17th. In addition to food and fellowship there will be a guest speaker who will be presenting on stewardship and its role in each of our daily lives, as stewards of our time and talents, as well as our wealth. The speaker will be Jeff Moretzsohn who will be speaking to us as a member of our newly established Diocesan Stewardship Committee. Jeff is also the administrator in one of our larger parishes in the Diocese – Church of the Good Samaritan, Paoli.

My best wishes to all of you for a happy and healthy summer, and a season of well deserved refreshment.
